

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility trials by contacting the AKC, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh NC 57617-3390, or by phone (919) 233-9767, by email info@akc.org or on their website www.akc.org.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the AKC rules and regulations for this sport, and that their dogs are able to perform all of the obstacles safely.

Entries must reach the Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM, February 17, 2017, but not before 8AM January 13, 2017. Fees must accompany entries and be paid in **U.S. currency, Payable to Karen Gloor. I cannot accept any Canadian checks (even with US funds written on the check) as I get charged \$25 at the bank to process the check. Fees can be sent via PayPal to karenagilitysecservices@gmail.com. NSF Checks** that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution will be assessed a service charge of \$35 per incident.

Entries without the AKC agreement on the back are not acceptable. Incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial (AKC Rules, Ch 14, Sec 4). Please indicate the dog's handler if the dog is co-owned or the handler is different than the owner. *Returned checks* will be charged a collection fee and will not constitute a valid entry.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded, if the trial cannot open or be completed due to acts beyond the control of the management

Entry fees will be refunded for bitches coming into season, or illness or injury to a dog after the closing date. A refund of \$10.00 per run entered will be made. If your dog is ill or injured, you will receive the refund upon receipt of veterinarian note. Request must be made prior to start of trial.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. There will be no refund of entry fees for exhibitors that are asked to leave the trial site due to their dogs or children creating unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engaging in unsafe behavior.

The judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging, owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for the judging of their class. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused.

Exhibitor's confirmation of entry will be **e-mailed** to the address given on the entry form and should be e-mailed no later than 7 days prior to the trial. Exhibitors not receiving a confirmation should notify the Trial Secretary.

THERE WILL BE NO SET-UPS ALLOWED PRIOR TO 3:00 PM ON THURSDAY, MARCH 2, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SHOW COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND THOSE ON THE OFFICIAL LIST OF SET-UP VOLUNTEERS. Thank you for your cooperation.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

All handlers are allowed to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge's briefing. A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs. Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles as listed in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

These trials are open to all dogs 15 months of age or over that are registered with the AKC, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number, or dogs listed with the AKC Canine Partners program. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance including dogs that are blind are not eligible to enter.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Green qualifying ribbons will be awarded. Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Rosettes will be awarded to those finishing a title. Rosettes will be awarded to Double Qualifiers in Masters only. MACH & PACH bars and titling rosettes will be awarded at this trial. All awards and prizes must be claimed at the trial - none will be mailed.

MOVE-UPS

All pre-show move-ups must be received by Mon. February 27, 2017, by 6:00 PM. AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. Send an email to Karen Gloor (rysaroni@cox.net) with your name, dog's call name, name and date of trial and what class you want to move up to.

Day to Day Move-ups, must be submitted no later than 15 minutes following the last class of the day. Forms will be available at the trial site.

Please Note: Dogs having attained their first AKC Agility Title (Std or JWW) must be moved to the Nov B class (Std or JWW) for all trials for which entries have not closed. If entries have already closed on the date the dog obtained its title, the dog shall remain in the class in which it was originally entered or be moved up in level (i.e. Novice to Open) at the request of the owner; subject to the move-up criteria, except as stated in Chapter 1, Sections 21 regarding Novice A entries. (as stated below)

Section 21 - A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or the handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to a Novice "B" class.

WAIT LIST

A Wait List is being offered to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trials closing date. A Maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM, February 17, 2017. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6pm February 24, 2017 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6pm February 24, 2017 will receive a full refund.

PREMIER CLASS

The premier classes are new to AKC. These optional titling classes are designed to challenge dogs and handlers at an increased speed and skill level above those set for the Master level classes. Handlers/dogs will need to negotiate courses that require varied approach angles, spacing, and obstacle discriminations to be successful in these classes. These classes are offered as separate titling tracks and are not part of the MACH/PACH Championships. Only dogs in Masters Standard or Masters JWW may enter the Premier classes.

Simplified Jump height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.

If your dog is under the age of two at trial date: One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date: A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record.

Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement: If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Request Perm" box at the bottom of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future.

What if my dog measures into a different jump height then what he is entered?

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process.

May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement? Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.) The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. When the 2nd or 3rd measurement is completed in the challenge measurement process, the new measurement is effective immediately.

Judges reserve the right to measure any dog they believe might belong in a different division, and dog whose entry in a given division might be questioned. In the Preferred Classes handlers must jump the height called for and may not jump higher.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
