This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc., hereinafter referred to as USDAA. The rules and regulations as amended July 1, 2009, and hereby incorporated by reference, shall apply at this event.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following rules and conditions for submission and acceptance of entry:

- This test is open to all USDAA-registered dogs at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that might affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.
- All dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in and have the appropriate U number prior to the competition in order to compete. Registration may be made concurrently with this entry to this Test, a form for which is included in this test schedule. To receive a registration number immediately and measurement/height card before the Test, go online at www.usdaa.com, click on "General Information" then "Dog Registration."
- No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- Safety shall always be a foremost consideration at all times. Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- Fault limits may be imposed in any class at the discretion of the organizing committee and judge.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to have his/her dog ready to compete and at the ring entrance when the steward calls.
- There will be no equipment familiarization at this test. Warm-up jumps will be provided.
- Dogs must remain on leash at all times, except when competing in the ring or at the warm-up jump.
- You must clean up after your dogs. Competitors are asked to keep their crate and exercise areas clean.
- Crates may be left at the site on Friday and Saturday night, but all live animals must be removed from the premises. A security guard will be on the premises but the site cannot be locked, so entrants are responsible for securing any valuables. Contact Zonies will not be liable for any loss due to theft, natural disasters, vandalism and Acts of God.
- Bathrooms are "PortaJohns."
- There will be food and other vendors on site.

ENTRIES AND REFUNDS

Entries must be received by **Monday, January 25 at 6:00 pm MST**. No changes will be accepted after closing. All entries must be in writing and either mailed or presented in person, with appropriate fees, to Karen Gloor, Show Secretary, or to her designated representative, by the closing date. Entries sent by overnight mail must be sent "no signature required." Contact Zonies reserves the right to refuse entries received after the closing date due to not signing the signature waiver. **Confirmation of entries will be provided by e-mail.**

No entry fee will be refunded:

- for entries withdrawn after the closing date
- for a dog or handler dismissed from the competition
- if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God (including weather that the Organizing Committee in its sole determination shall deem unsafe), public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.

A partial refund of 75 % of fees will be provided for bitches who come into season (with documentation) or for dogs and/or handlers who have medical documentation—of an illness or injury—preventing them from participating after the closing date. All other requests for a refund will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by the organizing committee.

It is the entrant's responsibility to check for errors before submitting entry forms to this club. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler. **You are advised to make a copy of your entry form and bring it, as well as your confirmation, to the event.**

Checks may be deposited upon receipt. Amounts overpaid on entry fees of \$10.00 or less shall not be refunded.

Competitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any competitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site. No refund will be made.

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee view that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

CHECK IN AND START TIMES

Friday: You may start setting up your spaces after 3 p.m. Early check-in will be offered from 4 p.m. to 5:30 pm (no measuring).

Saturday and Sunday: There will be a self-serve check-in available for those submitting a **COPY** of their permanent yellow plastic card(s) with their entry form(s). Handlers need only check in dogs their first day of competition. **Hosted** check in will be from **7:15–7:45 a.m.** on Saturday and **7:30–7:45 a.m.** on Sunday.

- You **must** present your USDAA card(s) during check-in if a copy was not submitted with entry form, so that registration numbers can be verified.
- All dogs must be measured prior to competing in their first class unless a copy of the permanent card has been provided with entry or is presented at check-in; a check-in letter from USDAA or a print-out of the subscriber dog-info form indicating the dog is permanently carded or a completed temporary height card waiting for a CMJ is presented.
- Participation in Championship, Performance, or Tournaments requires a “U” registration number.
- Dogs requiring measurement must be measured PRIOR to checking in.
- Dogs that measure up at this event may be run for exhibition only (non-qualifying) at the lower height; however, no qualifying scores or awards may be earned and no change in program is allowed.
- All times are tentative. Times may change due to number of entries.

****First class will begin at 8:00 a.m. each day.****

Always check your confirmation letter or email for any updates or changes to this schedule. General announcements will be made each day prior to first class.

RELEASE

All Competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association, Inc.

Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS AND HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Standard and non-standard Classes: 1st through 4th place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height for all classes except pairs, where ribbons will be awarded for mini and open divisions.

Grand Prix and Performance Grand Prix: Rosettes for 1st to 3rd place in each jump height. Dogs with qualifying scores in the Grand Prix shall receive a maroon and white qualifying ribbon, and qualifiers in Performance Grand Prix shall receive a maroon and pink ribbon.

Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping: See Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping information (included on **page 4** in this test schedule) for breakdown in prize money percentages.

No awards will be mailed; they must be claimed by the participant or their representative on the day of the competition.

AGILITY OBSTACLES AND JUMP HEIGHTS

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the official Rules and Regulations of the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc., and shall meet the requirements therein.

Following are the jump and obstacle heights in the Championship and Performance programs, with Performance in parentheses.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

The following titling classes are being offered at the Starters, Advanced, Masters, and Performance 1, 2, and 3 levels at this event: Jumpers, Standard, Gamblers, Pairs Relay, and Snooker. Competitors may enter a combination of Championship and Performance classes, but they may not enter a class in the same program on the same day, i.e., Standard Championship and Standard Performance. A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3-7 of the official USDAA[®] Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations.

TOURNAMENTS

The following 2010 tournament **local qualifiers** are being offered at this event:

- **Grand Prix of Dog Agility[®] World Championships**
- **Performance Grand PrixSM Championships**

2010 Grand Prix of Dog Agility[®] World Championships & Performance Grand Prix Championships

Local QualifiersSM

These single-round tournaments are judged under Masters rules. A dog may be entered in Grand Prix **or** Performance Grand Prix at this event but not both. Competitors earning zero (0) faults shall earn a qualifying score. The first place dog/handler in each jump height earning a qualifying score will be awarded a "bye" into the final round of the Regional Championship. One (1) qualifying score is required to enter round 1 of a Regional Championship and two (2) qualifying scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the World Championship.
